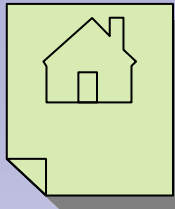
Property Inspections and Public Works

The Municipality of Argyle's Property Inspection and Public Works department is located in the municipal administration building in Tusket. The telephone number is (902)648-2623.

A section of this department deals with: Building and/or Development permits.

A Building and/or Development Permit is required for:

- New building construction
- Structural change
- Building demolition
- Building relocation
- Change of use
- Sheds, garages, and accessory structures
- Decks and stairs
- Roof enclosure over an existing or new deck
- Alterations/Renovations valued over \$5,000



A Building and/or Development Permit is not required for:

- Fences
- Cosmetic repairs such as painting
- Change of occupant with same use
- Replacing doors and windows in existing openings; unless the structure is altered
- Replacing roofing, unless the structure is altered
- Non-structural work value less than \$5,000

What are the permit fees?

- Residential, community Centers and Churches (Construction excluding unfinished basements): \$5.00 plus \$0.06 per sq. ft.
- Sheds, Garages, Barns and Farm Buildings: \$5.00 plus \$0.02 per sq. ft.
- Other non residential uses, such as Commercial and Industrial Buildings: \$5.00 plus \$0.10 per sq. ft.
- Alterations and Repairs: \$5.00 plus \$1.00 per \$1000.
- Demolition Permit and Development Permit: \$0.00

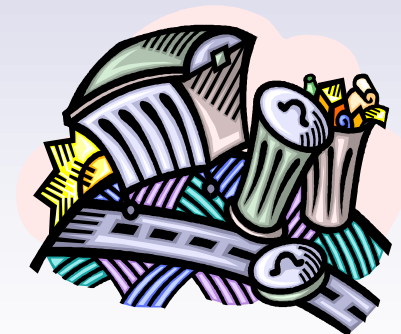
to residents of the Municipality of Argyle

Tipping fees at the Yarmouth County Transfer Station on the Hardscratch Road are waived for **RESIDENTIAL** waste for residents of the Municipality of Argyle. This **does not** include construction and demolition debris.

Residents may drop off large items (**at no cost**) such as stoves, freezers, refrigerators and furniture at the Transfer Station as part of this program. **Appliances do not need to have Freon removed.**

- **Waste must be properly separated**
- **Limited of 200 kgs (440 lbs) per resident per day**

This position was formally established in September 2006.

**Argyle Township Court House
Archives**

The Argyle Township Court House Archives moved into its new facilities in November 2006, after a closure of only two weeks. Located in the old Court House from 1982 to 2006, the archives had run out of space. In 2000 the Argyle Municipality Historical & Genealogical Society purchased the former Seventh-Day Adventist Church that is situated to the south of the Court House. Their plans were to preserve the heritage exterior of the church and transform the interior into a modern archival facility.











The archive's Grand Opening took place on June 15, 2007. On the evening of Thursday June 14 the Society held its annual general meeting in the courtroom of the Court House. A power-point slide presentation was given by the Project Manager for the New Archives Project, Keith Anthony, on all phases of the construction of the building. On Saturday June 16 an Open House was held at the new Archives.

On May 7 at the Destination Southwest Nova Scotia's annual general meeting, the Argyle Township Courthouse Archives was presented the award for the Yarmouth and Acadian shores region as recognition of their continued outstanding contribution to the tourism industry.

On May 10, the Courthouse was also awarded with the prestigious Carman V. Carroll Award "in recognition of outstanding achievement in archival preservation through the creation of a new environmentally controlled archival facility" as presented by the Council of Nova Scotia Archives.
