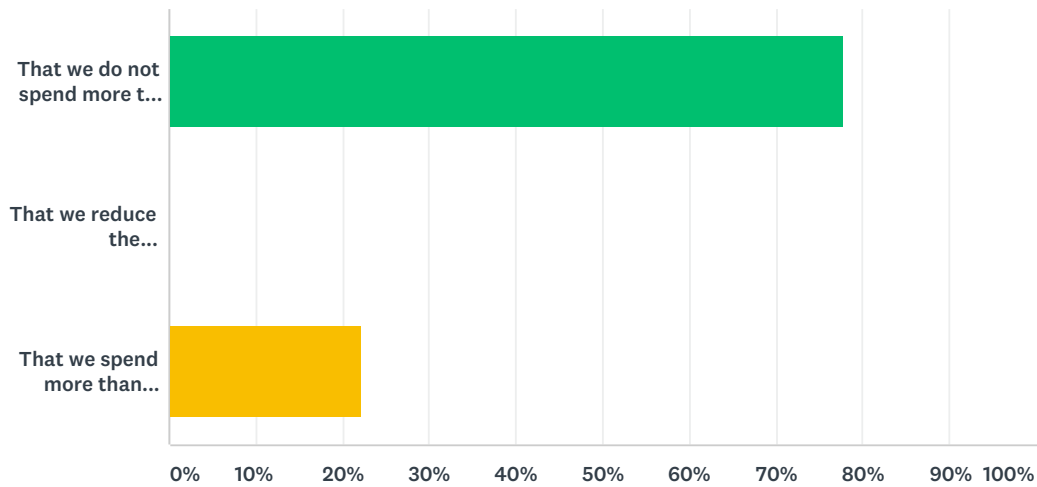


# Q1 Which of the following statements describe what is most important to you in building a new grants to organizations program?

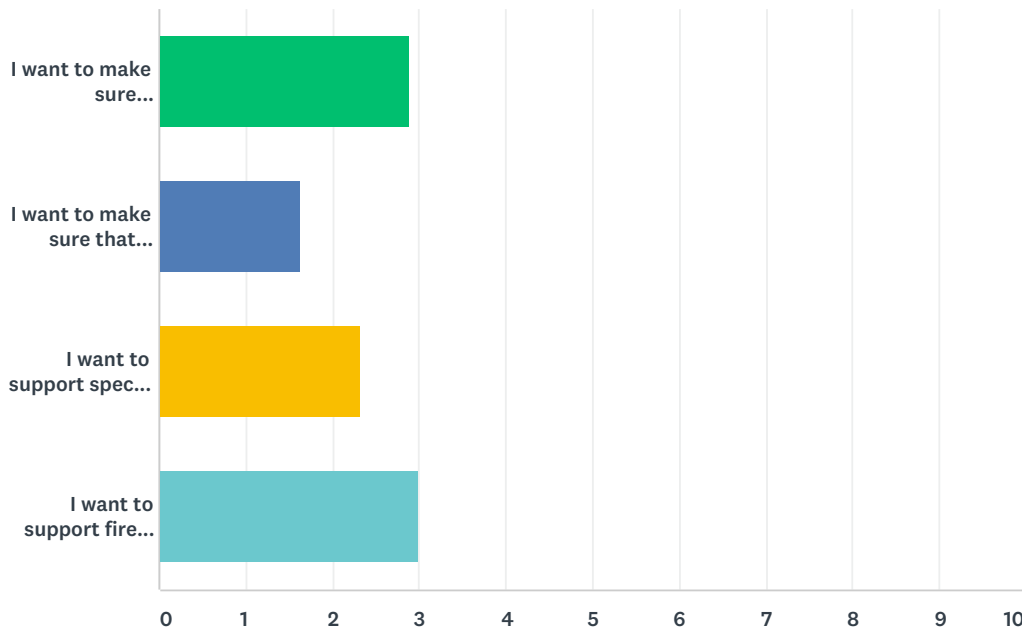

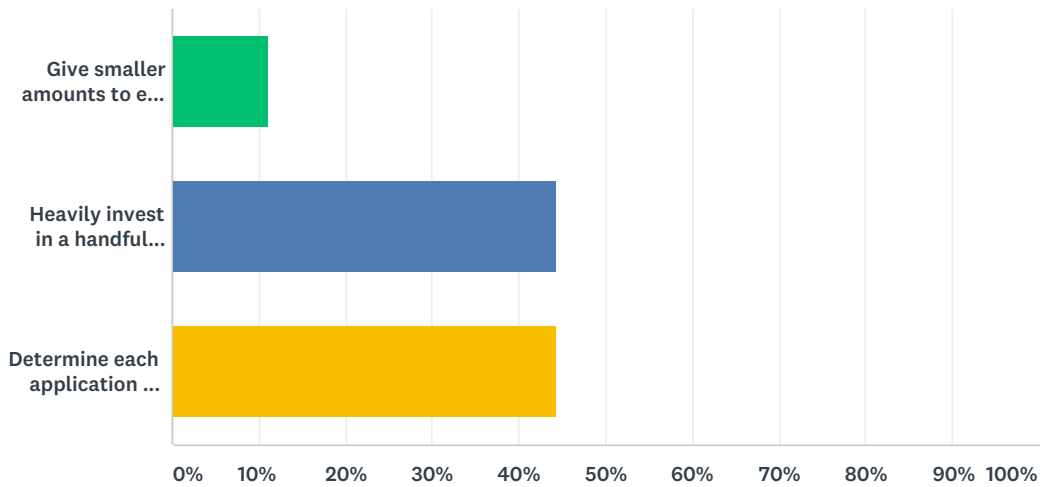

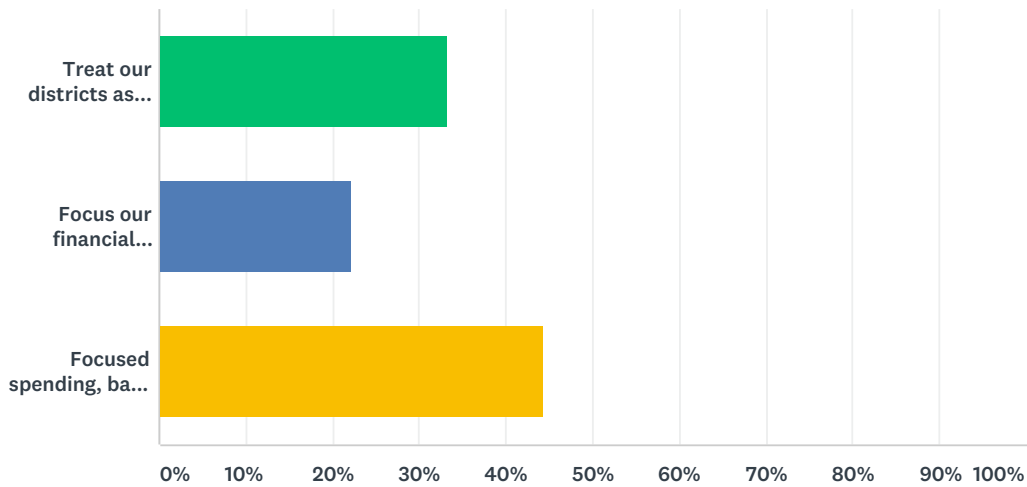

## Q6 When considering a new way to spend dollars supporting non-profit organizations, my preference is to:

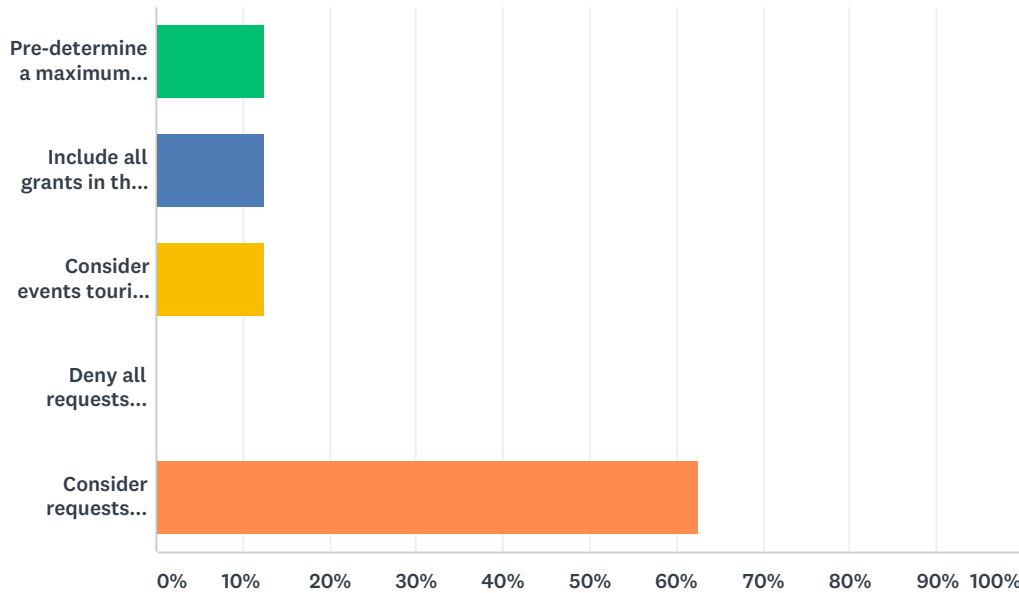

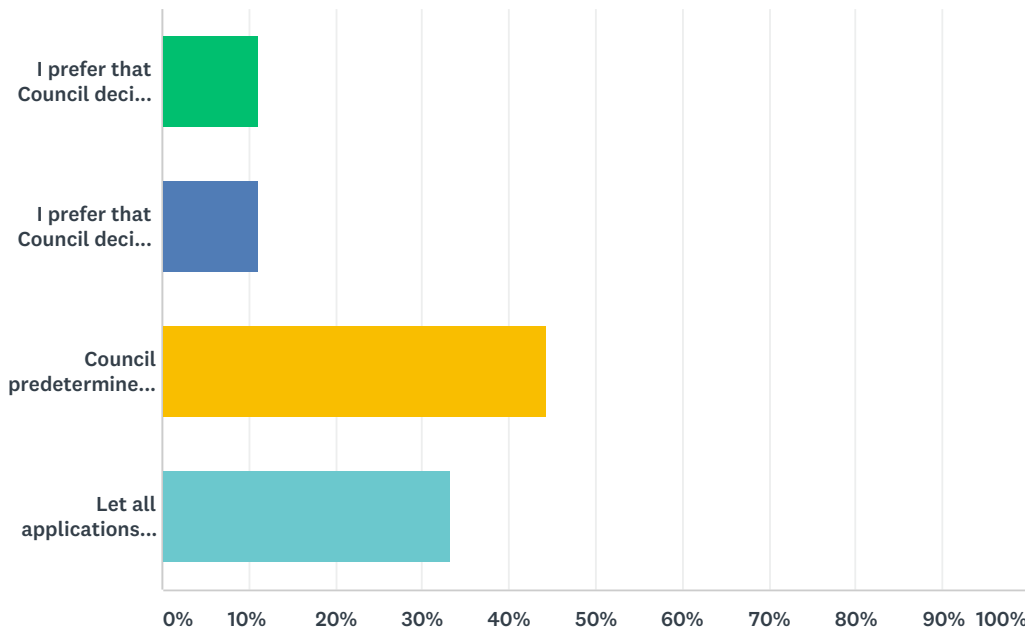

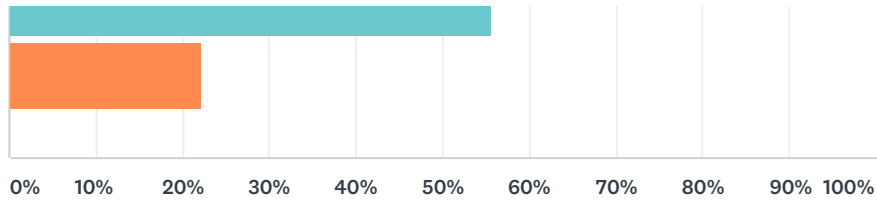


### Q9 When deciding where to invest grant dollars, you require information, please rate what information is most (or least) important for you to make a decision

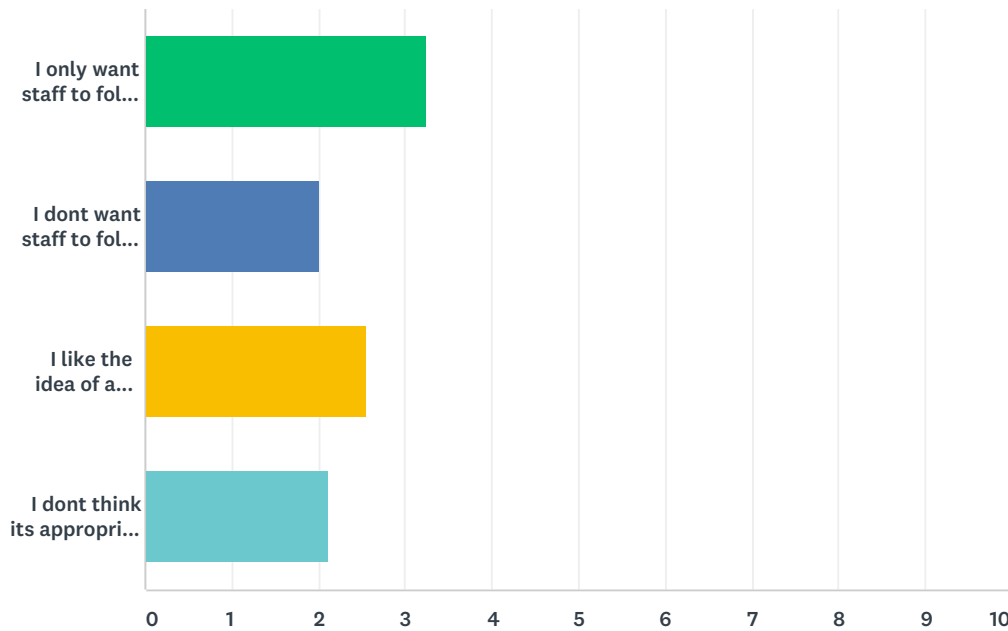
