RE: Road Safety Concerns for Intersection where Trunk 3 and Highway 335 meet in Pubnico, NS

This letter is to ask the Department of Public Works to revisit the safety concerns in Pubnico where Trunk 3 and Highway 335 meet. We thank you for your previous attention to this intersection, as the speed limit was lowered to 60 km, however, the safety issues are still a major concern for many at this location.

Some drivers are still travelling at a fast pace through the intersection, and as it is a blind corner for the driver at the stop sign, this has caused accidents in the past. It is also a concern for pedestrians who walk through there. There is a business that operates there year round, and in addition to the year-round business, there is also a seasonal business that operates right across the intersection during the summer months, and it creates extra traffic, thus adding to the safety concerns.

The Municipality would like the Department of Public Works to revisit this intersection and consider making it a 3-way stop sign to alleviate some of the safety concerns and forcing drivers to slow down.
