Dear Warden Muise:

Thank you for your email dated January 31, 2024, regarding safety concerns for the Intersection of Trunk 3 and Route 335, Yarmouth County.

The District Traffic Supervisor has conducted a review of the intersection at your request and has provided the comments below.

The evaluation of the Trunk 3 and Route 335 intersection in Pubnico does not meet the criteria for a multi-way stop as per Transport Canada guidelines.

Additionally, a review of the collision history at this intersection revealed minimal reported incidents, all primarily due to adverse winter conditions and driver errors unrelated to the intersection's layout.

Ultimately, this review has determined that a multi-way stop is not applicable for the Trunk 3 and Route 335 junction.
